INFORMATION REQUEST

York County Government is interested in identifying a site within the county boundaries of at least 160 acres to become the future home of the York County Fairgrounds, where a traditional annual authentic county fair can be held. Additional considerations for the site usage include: complementary multi-use buildings for hosting activities such as agricultural events (e.g. equine/livestock competitions), concerts/festivals, consumer/trade shows, civic/community events, local education events, craft fairs, family reunions, and farmer's markets.

All property owners or licensed representing agents interested in pursuing a possible land sale can express their interest by contacting Bennish Brown, Executive Director of the Rock Hill/York County Convention and Visitors Bureau during normal business hours, (8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.), Monday-Friday at 803-329-5200, or by emailing bennishbrown@visityorkcounty.com. Respondents should be prepared to provide the property tax parcel number, total acreage, street address, property photos, current utility providers, and a description of any special property features (i.e. streams, wetlands, structures, ponds, easements, etc.). The final selection of a parcel will be based upon available acreage, acreage location, existing utilities, contract negotiations, and price.
