2. Both trucks will be made available for viewing during normal business hours, Monday-Friday 8a.m. - 4p.m. Appointments can be made by contacting Randy Thompson, York County Fire Marshal. The trucks will not be available for viewing on Monday, February 8, 2010 through Friday, February 12, 2010.

3. Interested bidders should submit a sealed bid, on departmental logo, or letterhead paper and submitted as follows:
