Project Description:

The work generally consists of construction to improve a 0.815 mile section of Cherry Road (SC 322) in Rock Hill to a multi-lane (5-lane) section, including a center turn lane with curb and gutter and sidewalks between York Avenue and Heckle Boulevard (SC 901).

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

The Bids must be submitted on the bid form. Submit one (1) signed original and two (2) signed copies of bid form. Bids made otherwise will be subject to rejection. The above Bid # must be shown on front of the envelope in which this bid is submitted. York County assumes no responsibility for unmarked envelopes being considered for award. Authorized company representative is required to sign in the place indicated on the bid form. Bids not signed will automatically be rejected. It is requested that completed bids be either typewritten or handwritten in black ink only. Facsimiles are not acceptable. If County offices are closed due to inclement weather, the bids shall be opened at the same schedule hour on the 3rd working day (excluding County observed holidays) after the schedule bid opening date. LATE BIDS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

- a. **Submit one (1) signed original and two (2) signed copies of bid.**
- b. Bids, amendments thereto or withdrawal requests received after the time advertised for bid opening will be void regardless of when they were mailed.
- c. Quote prices on units specified with packing included.
- d. Attach complete specifications for any permitted substitutions offered or when amplification is desirable or necessary.
- e. If specifications or description papers are submitted with bids, enter bidder's name thereon.
- f. If the article bid upon has a trade name or brand, show same in the bid.
- g. When required, furnish samples, free of expense, prior to the opening of bids.
- h. Show delivery time required after order is received (see BID below).
- i. Address and mark bids as indicated in the notice.

CONDITIONS

- a. The County reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to waive all technicalities.
- b. Unit prices will govern over extended prices, unless otherwise stated in notice.
- c. Time in connection with discount offered, will be computed from date of delivery of commodities to carrier, when inspection and acceptance is at point of origin; or date of delivery at destination; or if laboratory inspection is made part of the bid, from date of laboratory report.
- d. In case of default of contractor, the County reserves the right to purchase any or all items in default in open market, charging contractor with any excessive costs. Should such change be assessed, no subsequent bids nor the defaulting contractor will be considered until the assessed charge has been satisfied.
- e. All materials and products offered must be guaranteed to meet the requirements of the specifications indicated, given or referred to.
- f. Prices bid must be based upon payment in thirty days. Discounts for payment in less than thirty days will not be considered in making award.
- g. The right is reserved in case tie bids are received to make award as considered to be most advantageous to the County.
- h. The right is reserved to reject any bid in which the delivery time indicated is considered sufficient to delay the operation for which the commodity is intended.
- i. Unless otherwise indicated by the Procurement Director, prices must be firm.
- j. The successful bidder shall indemnify and save harmless the County of York and all County officials, agents and employees, from all suits or claims of any character brought by reason of infringing on any patent trade mark or copyright.

This Addendum becomes a part of the Contract Documents and modifies the original Contract Documents dated October 28, 2009. All bidders shall acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in the Bid Proposal Forms.

DIVISION I-SECTION 1, INVITATION FOR BIDS

The Invitation for Bids shall be deleted and replaced with the attached document. The revised invitation changes the bid opening date from Tuesday, December 1, 2009, to Tuesday, January 19, 2010.

DIVISION I-SECTION 3A, BID PROPOSAL FORM AND SCHEDULE

1. Contractor shall use the attached revised Bid Proposal Form for submitting the bid. Unit quantity revisions to the Bid Proposal Form are as follows:
 - a. Item 2021000, Removal and Disposal of Structures and Obstructions: NEC (Lump Sum)

DIVISION II-SECTION 2, SPECIAL PROVISIONS

1. REVISE SPECIAL PROVISION NO. 2, Paragraph 2 to read, "LANE CLOSURES FOR PAVEMENT TIE-INS AND OTHER WORK ADJACENT TO TRAVEL LANES ON SC ROUTE 322 SHALL BE RESTRICTED BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 9 AM AND 4 PM. LANE CLOSURES AND TIMES DIFFERING FROM WHAT IS DETAILED IN THE PLANS AND DESCRIBED HEREIN SHALL OBTAIN APPROVAL FROM THE ENGINEER."
2. REVISE SPECIAL PROVISION NO. 15 to read, "For this project, the liquid Asphalt Cement adjustment will be made utilizing the index dated November 1, 2009 as the base index."

CLARIFICATIONS

1. Division I, Section 4C, Special Condition No. 1, specifies that payment for the removal and satisfactory disposal of all underground storage tanks shall be included in the lump sum bid item "Removal and Disposal of Structures and Obstructions." Pay Item No. 2021000 "Removal of Structures and Obstructions", has been added to the attached Bid Schedule.
2. Night Time Lane Closures: Work at night shall be performed in accordance with SCDOT 2007 Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, and the contract documents. Work at night must be approved in advance by the Engineer.
3. Cement Modified Recycled Base Course (CMRB): CMRB shall be constructed in conformance with Sections 301 and 306 of the SCDOT 2007 Standard Specifications for Highway Construction. Cure the CMRB for three days in accordance with Sections 301.4.8 and 306.4.8 unless otherwise directed by the Engineer.
